- Resident does not come to Gardening Club, her most enjoyed program, as her showers are scheduled for this time.
- Resident is escorted out of a program he is enjoying by a C.N.A. back to his room so he can have a nap.
- Resident is one of the last to receive her medications, and shows up at her favorite ceramic glass late. This class is taught by Adult Education and requires a certain number of residents to attend. Her perceived tardiness impacts the attendance records and jeopardizes the class.
- Residents are complaining that Ethel's Sing-A-Long is boring, "she can't carry a tune" and consider the program "cruel and unusual punishment". Staff continue to bring them to the program. They cannot wheel themselves away, and are subjected to an event that is unpleasant for them.
